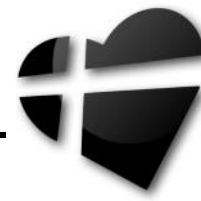

Use this “@Home Guide” as a blueprint for spiritual conversations at home. Every home is encouraged to be a “See and Share” home. Wonderful things discovered about Jesus should be shared with others in the home, just as He is talked about in the church building. Share at home what you see in church.

Young Families with Children

Young families are encouraged to use the weekly envelopes and placemat to complete simple, encouraging faith conversations at home. The complete script for the conversation is in the envelope, so even inexperienced parents will hit a home run. A handful of random envelopes will receive a prize every week, and every time a family records 3, 6 and 10 activities on their placemat, they will receive a prize that will bless their family. You can pick up placemats, envelopes and prizes at @home central near the central stairwell.

Families with Teenagers

Teens and adults will be going through the same Sunday School curriculum. These families are encouraged to use the placemat to make family goals and track conversations they have about what they are learning and experiencing in class, in the service, and how that applies to life. Parents can easily adapt envelope content for use with teens.

Couples

Couples are encouraged to deepen their relationship with one another by seeing and sharing discoveries they are making about Christ this summer. Couples can encourage one another to pursue Christ at home and at church with passion. Pray together as you love and surrender to the King of Kings.

Singles

Singles can use their homes to deepen their relationship with Christ through the *First Place Love* curriculum. Homes of singles can be places to connect with extended family and friends to see and share together the glories of Christ.
