1. How is the church the hope for the world to hear the gospel?
2. What are some cautions that are given regarding spiritual gifts? How can we avoid those traps? If we do, what would be the likely outcome in the church? How would the church be better prepared to engage the world with the gospel?
3. How can unity thrive in the church among believers who disappoint and hurt one another? How can a Christian's response to being wronged glorify Christ and the gospel?
4. Dr. Booth's sermon gave focus to Colossians 3:18-21. Can the commands given here be accomplished apart from Christ? In what ways is the gospel good news for your family?
5. How can we determine which end times issues are essential and which are non-essential for Christian unity? How can a study of the end times result in disunity? How can Christ be glorified through a study of the end times?
6. How does studying the end times magnify the supremacy of Christ? How does seeing Jesus in future prophecies reveal His ascension glory? How does that change how we relate to Him today?
7. BONUS: How does the supremacy of Christ bring unity to dispensational vs. covenant theologies? FOR FUN: Make a pretend prediction of Christ's return. How does having a date pull you toward urgency in Kingdom-first living, or lull you apathy? Can you see the wisdom of God in not providing a date? According to Matthew 24:14, what must happen prior to the return of Christ?
8. How can we be confident at the Great White Throne Judgment that we will be among the "sheep" and not the "goats"? What is the role of good works in that confidence?
9. How do rewards given at the Judgment Seat of Christ give us motivation to live for Him? In living for Him, which good works will pass the test of fire? Which will be burned up? What will the "loss" suffered by one who is still saved, but not rewarded?
10. Imagine living face to face with God. What excites you about heaven? How does the idea of unhindered relationship effect your relationship with God now? What is now hindered about our relationship with Christ? What is unhindered because of the gospel?
