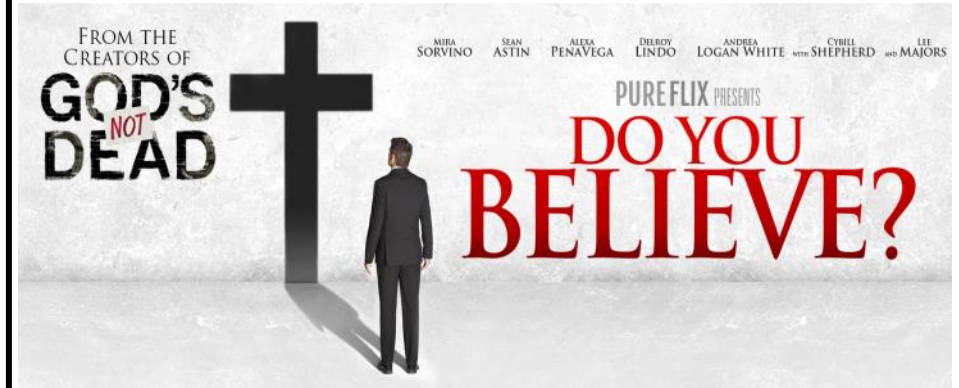

Use this "@Home Guide" as a blueprint for spiritual conversations at home. Every home is encouraged to be a "See and Share" home. Wonderful things discovered about Jesus should be shared with others in the home, just as He is talked about in the church building. Share at home what you see in church.

Young Families with Children

Young families are encouraged to use the weekly envelopes and placemat to complete simple, encouraging faith conversations at home. The complete script for the conversation is in the envelope, so even inexperienced parents will hit a home run. A handful of random envelopes will receive a prize every week, and every time a family records 3, 6 and 10 activities on their placemat, they will receive a prize that will bless their family. You can pick up placemats, envelopes and prizes at @home central near the central stairwell.

Families with Teenagers

Teens and adults will be going through the same Sunday School curriculum.
